	<i>Costa del Sol, A region in the south of Spain, comprising the coastal towns and communities along the coastline of the Province of Málaga.</i>		
03 Fri	COSTA DEL SOL – TARIFA – TANGIER – RABAT – CASABLANCA Drive along the picturesque tourist route of Costa del Sol via internationally renowned places as Marbella and Puerto Banus. Arrived to Tarifa where a ferry boat will be used for a short and interesting crossing of the strait of Gibraltar towards Africa. Arrival to Tangier , disembark, clear customs and drive southwards via Larache to Rabat , diplomatic and administrative capital, official residence of the King Mohamed VI. City tour visiting the important sights as the Royal Palace from outside, Mohamed V Mausoleum and the unfinished Hassan Tower which are important examples of the Almohade architecture. 04 Sat	CASABLANCA - MARRAKECH Casablanca panoramic city tour through the most interesting sections of the city, Anfa boulevard, Nations square, residential areas and visit from the outside of the Hassan II grand mosque. Departure towards Marrakech , capital of the South, which is located within an extensive oasis between the Atlas Mountains and the pre-desertic area. City sightseeing including the Koutoubia Tower (same pattern as twin tower of the Giralda in Seville), Saadines Tombs and Bay Palace , walk around the medina, souks and the magic Jemaa El Fna Square , which is packed with fortune tellers, snake tamers, acrobats, dancers, all making the centre of the city an open air theatre that requires the participation of the audience. Don't forget your camera. Overnight in Marrakech. <i>Optional dinner and show at Chez Ali Fantasia.</i>	(Breakfast /Dinner)	 Jemaa El Fna Square @ Marrakech
05 Sun	MARRAKECH – MEKNES - FEZ Depart northeast to Meknes , old walled (40 Kms.) imperial city located in the heart of the Mid Atlas. Panoramic tour; admire the great Bab Al Mansour Gate , Morocco's most beautiful gate and the most well known monument in town. Afterwards departure to Fez , the most monumental one of the Imperial Cities, its University of "Karaouyne" is the largest Islamic sanctuary in Morocco, ancient theological schools, etc. Overnight in Fez. Passengers are deemed to have read, understood and accepted the following:-

Package Price

Quoted in Euro Dollar (EUR). Payment in local currency (RM) and subject to exchange rate fluctuations. Validity of prices is seasonal and subject to change without prior notice. Child rates are applicable when child is occupying a room with at least two adults.

Deposit & Payment

A deposit of 20% of the tour package per person is required when booking is made. Receipt for deposit is valid for three (3) months from the date of issue. The deposit forms part of your final payment. Balance (final payment) must be made 30 days prior to departure. Failure to comply with this may result in an automatic cancellation of your reservations and forfeiture of your deposit.

Accommodation

Bedding varies from hotel to hotel, but the following usually applies:-

Single Occupancy: comprises 1 Queen/1 Twin Bed

Double Occupancy: comprises 1 Queen/King Bed

Twin Occupancy: comprises 2 Single Beds

Triple Occupancy: comprises 3 Single / 1 Double + Rollaway Bed

If a rollaway bed is required, an extra charge applies. Most hotels will not put more than one rollaway in a room. Baby cots can be requested in advance and if extra charge applies, passenger must pay directly to hotel.

Hotel Check-In/Out Times : Standard check-in time is after 1500hrs and check-out is before 1100hrs

*Baggage Policy

The warehouse space of the coaches is limited. One suitcase per person of a maximum 25kg and maximum measures of 157cm dimensions (the dimensional measurement in the sum of length, width and height). Only suitcase of higher measure will be accepted if shared between two passengers. Excess baggage penalties: Supplement of €30 per extra standard suitcase; €50 for extra oversize suitcase and €30 for oversize suitcase instead of regular. Only one hand baggage per person is allowed

Amendment Charges

An administrative fee of RM100 will be charged for each subsequent amendment made after the confirmation. Any other cost arising from the amendment will be borne by the passenger. No amendment can be made within 30 days prior to departure. A change on the entire booking is considered a cancellation and is subject to cancellation charges.

Cancellation Charges

You may cancel your booking at any time. Cancellation must be made in writing to avoid any misunderstanding. If your cancellation is received by the Company more than 30 days prior to your departure, an administration fee of RM100 per person will be levied. If your notice of cancellation is received fewer than 30 days prior to departure, the following cancellation charges will apply:

Request for refund as a result of changes to the package must be made in writing and an administrative fee of RM100 per person applies in addition to the supplier's cancellation fee.
