DAY 1 | WELCOME TO MADRID

Join your Travel Director and fellow travellers for dinner in a local restaurant and enjoy an evening of delicious food and wine. (D)

DAY 2 | MADRID OF THE BOURBONS

Enjoy sightseeing with your Local Expert as they take you along the main historical areas in the capital of Spain, known as Madrid of the Bourbons.
