DAY	ITINERARY
01	AUCKLAND - ARRIVAL On arrival you will be met and privately transferred to your accommodation. Auckland is New Zealand's largest city, set between two harbours with gentle sandy shores on the east coast, wild surf beaches on the west coast.
02	AUCKLAND – HOBBITON – ROTORUA (Lunch) Today's coach tour takes you to the rolling green hills of the iconic Hobbiton Movie Set. Explore Hobbit Holes, the Mill, and The Green Dragon Inn, and hear behind-the-scenes tales of transforming farmland into Middle-earth.
03	ROTORUA (Buffet Dinner) You will be transported to Wai-O-Tapu Geothermal Wonderland for a two hour visit today. Wai-O-Tapu is considered to be New Zealand's most colourful and diverse geothermal sightseeing attraction. This evening you'll be transported to Te Puia for an Indigenous Evening Experience including a buffet dinner and cultural performance.
04	ROTORUA – CHRISTCHURCH (Flight Not Included) Depart on your domestic flight to Christchurch. Christchurch is set between the deep blue Pacific Ocean and the mighty snow-capped Southern Alps. This is a vibrant, ever-changing city with inner city parks and gardens delightfully interwoven by the meandering Avon River.
05	CHRISTCHURCH – GREYMOUTH You will be transported to the Christchurch Railway Station for the Tranz Alpine train crossing the vast expanses of the Canterbury Plains. On arrival in Greymouth, you will be met and transferred to the Punakaiki Pancake Rocks and Blowholes for a short self-guided walk to view the fascinating pancake-shaped rock formations before being delivered to your accommodation.
06	GREYMOUTH – FRANZ JOSEF You'll be transferred to Shantytown Heritage Park for a sense of what it was like to live in New Zealand during the gold rush before returning to Greymouth for your transfer to Glacier Country. The temperate climate at a low altitude makes Franz Josef and Fox Glaciers among the most convenient to visit in the world.
07	FRANZ JOSEF – QUEENSTOWN You will be collected from your accommodation for your transfer through wilderness towns, waterfalls and river scenery on the journey to Queenstown. Magnificent vistas and majestic mountains dominate this compact alpine resort town and with such an expansive natural physical environment
08	QUEENSTOWN A free day to explore the endless optional attractions available
09	QUEENSTOWN – MILFORD SOUND – QUEENSTOWN (Lunch) This tour takes you past mirror lakes and waterfalls into Milford Sound, carved by ice age glaciers and famously described as the eighth wonder of the world. On arrival, board your vessel for a cruise of the fiord surrounded by towering mountains and cliffs that plunge into the sea.
10	QUEENSTOWN – MT COOK/TAKAPO - CHRISTCHURCH Departs Queenstown through the stunning Kawarau Gorge and fruit and wine growing region of Cromwell. Travel the vast plains of the Mackenzie district, alongside magnificent turquoise blue lakes, framed by Aoraki Mt Cook and the spectacular Southern Alps to Mt Cook Village where you have some free time.

Package Price

Quoted in New Zealand Dollar (NZD) and payment in Ringgit Malaysia (RM). Validity of prices is seasonal and subject to change without prior notice. Child rates are applicable when child are occupying a room with at least two adult.

Deposit & Payment

A deposit of RM500 per person is required when booking is made. Receipt for deposit is valid for three (3) months from the date of issue. The deposit forms part of your final payment. Balance (final payment) must be made 15 days prior to departure. Failure to comply with this may result in an automatic cancellation of your reservations and forfeiture of your deposit.

Accommodation

Bedding varies from hotel to hotel, but the following usually applies:-

Single Occupancy: comprises 1 Queen/1 Twin Bed

Twin Occupancy: comprises 2 Single Beds

Rollaway Bed

Double Occupancy: comprises 1 Queen/King Bed

Triple Occupancy: comprises 3 Single / 1 Double +

If a rollaway bed is required, an extra charge applies. Most hotels will not put more than one rollaway in a room. Baby cots can be requested in advance and if extra charge applies, passenger must pay directly to hotel.

Gratuities: Guideline: NZD5 per person per day for driver and guide.

Hotel Check-In/Out Times : Standard check-in time is after 1500hrs and check-out is before 1100hrs

Amendment Charges

An administrative fee of RM100 will be charged for each subsequent amendment made after the confirmation. Any other cost arising from the amendment will be borne by the passenger. No amendment can be made within 15 days prior to departure. A change on the entire booking is considered a cancellation and is subject to cancellation charges.

Cancellation Charges
