DAY ITINERARY

01 NAIROBI - ARRIVAL

(Dinner)

Arrive at Nairobi International airport, meet by local representative. Visit Giraffe Centre and Karen Blixen Museum. Transfer to hotel for check in. The rest of the day at leisure.

Nairobi, the capital of Kenya and Africa's 4th largest city situated in along the Nairobi River. It serves as an excellent starting point for African safari trips around Kenya.



02 NAIROBI – ABERDARE NATIONAL PARK

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Depart for **Aberdare National Park** (155kms/Approx. 3.5hrs). Arrive Aberdare Country Club and check in. Leave your Luggage here for storage and lunch is serve. Transfer to **The Ark** with an overnight bag. Arrive at the Ark, enjoy afternoon tea and watch the animals from various observation platforms both on ground and above ground level. Animal watching continues throughout the night. Should you wish to sleep, you can ask to be woken up when an animal you really want to see come by The Ark. Overnight stay at The Ark Lodge.

Aberdare National Park, located northeast of Nairobi, Kenya, The park is inhabited by a variety of African wildlife such as: elephant, lion, spotted hyena, rhino, black leopard and the very elusive bongo antelope that lives in the high altitude bamboo forests



03 ABERDARE NATIONAL PARK – LAKE NAKURU NATIONAL PARK

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

After breakfast, transfer back to Aberdare Country Club and pick up your luggage. Depart for **Lake Nakuru National Park** (156kms/Approx. 3hrs) and en-route stop by **The Equator** for pictures. Arrive at the lodge and check in. After lunch, game drive begins.

Lake Nakuru National Park, located in the Great Rift Valley surrounded by yellow acacia woodlands and bushy shrublands,. The national park is inhabited by over 50 mammal species including hippo, black and white rhino, Rothschild giraffe, buffalo and eland. Known as a bird watcher's paradise. Don't miss the opportunity to visit the beautiful Makalia Waterfall.



04 LAKE NAKURU NATIONAL PARK - MASAI MARA NATIONAL RESERVE

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Depart for **Masai Mara National Reserve** (220kms/Approx. 5.5hrs). Lunch at Sarova Mara Game Camp. At leisure till afternoon game drive.

Masai Mara National Reserve, the undeniable is undoubtedly the annual wildebeest migration traversing the vast plains of the Serengeti and the Masai Mara. It is known as the largest mass movement of land mammals on the planet – with more than a million animals following the rains.



05 MASAI MARA NATIONAL RESERVE

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Depart for morning game drive* Picnic lunch nearby Mara River. After lunch game drive continues. Visit **Masai Village** along the way.

* Should you join *optional Balloon Safari (approximately US\$480)*, this would replace your morning game drive. Pre-dawn pick up, flight from 6am for approximately 1hour. Champagne breakfast. Drop off at the lodge.



06 MASAI MARA NATIONAL RESERVE – LAKE NAIVASHA

(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Depart for **Lake Naivasha** (230kms/Approx. 6hrs), lunch at lodge. After lunch, enjoy a **1hour Boat Ride** on Lake Naivasha. Land on **Crescent Island** and enjoy a 1hour walk among its resident animals which include Giraffe, Gnu, Zebra, Impala, Gazelle, Dikdik, Mongoose as well as various birds.

Lake Naivasha, located in the Great Rift Valley surrounded by yellow acacia woodlands and bushy shrublands,. The national park is inhabited by over 50 mammal species including hippo, black and white rhino, Rothschild giraffe, buffalo and eland. Known as a bird watcher's paradise, the park is home to over 450 bird species.



07 LAKE NAIVASHA - NAIROBI – DEPARTURE

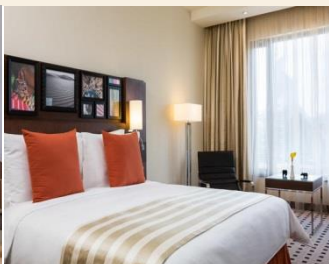

Package Price

Quoted in US Dollar (USD) and payment in Ringgit Malaysia (RM), subject to currency fluctuation. Validity of prices is seasonal and subject to change without prior notice. Child (3-11yrs) rates are applicable when child are occupying a room with at least two adult.

Deposit & Payment

A deposit of RM2000 per person is required when booking is made. Receipt for deposit is valid for three (3) months from the date of issue. The deposit forms part of your final payment. Balance (final payment) must be made 15 days prior to departure. Failure to comply with this may result in an automatic cancellation of your reservations and forfeiture of your deposit.

Accommodation

Bedding varies from hotel to hotel, but the following usually applies:-
