- 01 ISTANBUL – ARRIVAL** (Dinner)

- 03 KUSADASI –PAMUKKALE** (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)  
Visit Ephesus Antique City and Leather Outlet Center. Continue journey to Pamukkale.
- 04 PAMUKKALE – KONYA – CAPPADOCIA** (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)  
Depart to Cappadocia. En-route visit Mevlana Museum and the 13<sup>th</sup> century Sultanhani Caravanserai.
- 05 CAPPADOCIA** (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)  
Visit the incredible underground city, Pigeons Valley, Uchisar village.
- 06 CAPPADOCIA – ESKISEHIR** (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)  
Depart to Eskisehir – capital of Turkey. Visit Kursunlu Mosque Complex. Odunpazari District (UNESCO heritage site).
- 07 ESKISEHIR – ISTANBUL** (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)  
Depart to Istanbul and visit Blue Mosque, Hippodrome and Topkapi Palace.
- 08 ISTANBUL - DEPARTURE** (Breakfast)  
Depart Istanbul, transfer to the airport.

DAY	ITINERARY	
01	<b>ARRIVE ISTANBUL</b>	<b>(Dinner)</b>
	Arrive at Istanbul. Meet and greet by tour guide, then proceed an orientation tour of Istanbul (depending on arrival time). Then, transfer to hotel for dinner.	
02	<b>ISTANBUL – IZMIR – KUSADASI</b>	<b>(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)</b>
	Depart to <b>Izmir</b> . We will have free time at Izmir, you will see the historical elevator, Konak Square and more. Then drive to Kusadasi.	
03	<b>KUSADASI – PAMUKKALE</b>	<b>(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)</b>
	Drive to Selcuk to visit <b>Ephesus</b> as well as viewing one of <b>the Seven Churches of Revelation, the Temple of Artemis</b> (One of the Seven Wonders of Antiquity) and the <b>Basilica of St. John</b> from a distance, followed by lunch in the township of Selcuk. After lunch visit the famous local production center for leather garments whereby after a live Fashion Show time will be allocated for shopping. Then continue to <b>Pamukkale</b> . You will tour the Ancient City of Hierapolis today called Pamukkale where Calcareous hot springs descending over cliffs have created fascinating travertines in the form of white terrace and basins. After a picture break, dinner and overnight.	
04	<b>PAMUKKALE – KONYA – CAPPADOCIA</b>	<b>(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)</b>
	Early morning, drive through an interesting landscape where peasants make their living, to have lunch enroute before arriving in Konya. <b>Konya</b> was the center of the Seljuk Empire as well as the city of Mevlana and his Whirling Dervishes. After visiting the <b>Mevlana Museum</b> , we will continue to <b>Cappadocia</b> and visit the <b>Sultanhani Caravanserai</b> .	
05	<b>CAPPADOCIA</b>	<b>(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)</b>
	Breakfast at the hotel. Full day excursion tour of the Cappadocia region. Highlights of the day; Underground city, <b>Pasabag Valley</b> , <b>Uçhisar village</b> , traditional handmade <b>Carpet Factory</b> , <b>Pottery in Avanos Village</b> .	
06	<b>CAPPADOCIA – ESKISEHIR</b>	<b>(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)</b>
	Drive to <b>Eskisehir</b> or "old city" in Turkish. Visit the <b>Kursunlu Mosque Complex</b> built in 1525 by Mustafa Pasha during the time of Suleiman the magnificent. The mosque consist a fountain in the courtyard, a rest house, a kitchen and a caravanserai in the middle. There are also rooms in the complex and a place called mevlevihane (secluded praying house). At the back of the mosque are family graves belonging to last Mevlevi sheikh Hasan dede. Enjoy a stroll around the historical houses of <b>Odunpazarı district</b> famed for its colourful houses and also a destined UNESCO heritage site.	
07	<b>ESKISEHIR – ISTANBUL</b>	<b>(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)</b>
	Depart to Istanbul, visit <b>Blue Mosque</b> , famous for its blue tiles and unique with its 6 minarets built in the name of Sultan Ahmet. Then <b>Hippodrome</b> – where chariot races and gladiator sports used to take place. Then visit the marvelous oriental <b>Topkapi Palace</b> .	
08	<b>DEPARTURE ISTANBUL</b>	<b>(Breakfast)</b>
	After breakfast, drop to the 500year old <b>Grand Bazaar</b> - a maze of more than 4000 stalls and shops. Then, transfer to the airport.	

## TERMS & CONDITIONS

Passengers are deemed to have read, understood and accepted the following:-

### Package Price

Quoted in Ringgit Malaysia (RM). Validity of prices is seasonal and subject to change without prior notice. Child rates are applicable when child are occupying a room with at least 2 adults.

### Deposit & Payment

A deposit of RM500 per person is required when booking is made. Receipt for deposit is valid for three (3) months from the date of issue. The deposit forms part of your final payment. Balance (final payment) must be made 15 days prior to departure. Failure to comply with this may result in an automatic cancellation of your reservations and forfeiture of your deposit.

### Accommodation

Bedding varies from hotel to hotel, but the following usually applies:-

Single Occupancy: comprises 1 Queen/1 Twin Bed

Double Occupancy: comprises 1 Queen/King Bed

Twin Occupancy: comprises 2 Single Beds

Triple Occupancy: comprises 3 Single / 1 Double + Rollaway Bed

If a rollaway bed is required, an extra charge applies. Most hotels will not put more than one rollaway in a room. Baby cots can be requested in advance and if extra charge applies, passenger must pay directly to hotel.

**Hotel Check-In/Out Times :** Standard check-in time is after 1500hrs and check-out is before 1100hrs

### Amendment Charges

An administrative fee of RM100 will be charged for each subsequent amendment made after the confirmation. Any other cost arising from the amendment will be borne by the passenger. No amendment can be made within 15 days prior to departure. A change on the entire booking is considered a cancellation and is subject to cancellation charges.

### Cancellation Charges

You may cancel your booking at any time. Cancellation must be made in writing to avoid any misunderstanding. If your cancellation is received by the Company more than 30 days prior to your departure, an administration fee of RM100 per person will be levied.
