<b>02</b> Sat	<b>BARCELONA</b> Call on Julia Travel bus terminal (Balmes, 5) at 8:00am for a morning Highlights tour of Barcelona. A guided walking tour through Gothic Quarter the oldest part of the city, Las Ramblas, de Cathedral Square, the Old Jewish Quarter. Later we will take the bus tour around the rest of the city. Pass through the elegant Passeig de Gràcia Street, the Triumph Arc, the Olympic Village, Next, we will access to the Montjuic Mountain, was the main scenery of the Olympic Games in 1992. We will have opportunity to enjoy the panoramic views of the city riding the aerial tramway subject to weather conditions). Later visit Spanish Village (Poble Espanyol). Return to city and tour end at <b>Catalunya Square</b> . Afternoon at leisure. Overnight in Barcelona.	<b>(Breakfast)</b>  Spanish Village

Enjoy the journey with the comfort and operating speed of this AVE train. Arrival at 11:45 am. Transfer from station to your hotel. The rest of the day at leisure. Overnight in Madrid. <i>Train schedule subject to change.</i>	<b>(Breakfast)</b> 
<b>04</b> Mon	<b>MADRID – CORDOBA – SEVILLE</b> Pick up at your hotel and transfer to Juliá Travel bus terminal, located in the underground parking of the Plaza de Oriente. Departure at 08:30 a.m. Drive along La Mancha, Don Quixote's land. Brief stop at typical site in Puerto Lapice. Cross through the natural border of "Despeñaperros" and get into Andalusia and reach <b>Cordoba</b> . Impressive tour of its <b>Mosque-Cathedral of Cordoba</b> and other sites that will ease our mind and spirit strolling through its narrow winding streets of the Jewish Quarter. In the afternoon, after a short two hours ride reach <b>Seville</b> . Overnight in Seville.	<b>(Breakfast/Dinner)</b>  Mosque-Cathedral of Cordoba
<b>05</b> Tue	<b>SEVILLE</b> Morning Seville panoramic city tour visiting: the exterior of the <b>Cathedral</b> (the second largest in the Catholic world after St. Peters in Rome), <b>Santa Cruz quarter</b> (a natural scenario of "Carmen" as well as a precisely where the myth of "Don Juan" developed), <b>Maria Luisa Park</b> and <b>Plaza de España</b> . Afternoon at leisure. Overnight in Costa del Sol. <i>Optional Flamenco Tour</i>	<b>(Breakfast/Dinner)</b>  Cathedral of Seville
<b>06</b> Wed	<b>SEVILLE - GRANADA</b> Drive east through the Caliphate road to the heart of Andalusia and reach <b>Granada</b> . Visit the world famous <b>Alhambra Complex and Generalife Gardens</b> (UNESCO World Heritage Site), that have inspired several authors with its sound and sights, such as the "Tales of the Alhambra" by W. Irving. Overnight in Granada. <i>Optional Gipsy Flamenco show at Sacromonte quarter</i>	<b>(Breakfast/Dinner)</b>  Alhambra & Generalife Gardens
<b>07</b> Thu	<b>GRANADA – TOLEDO - MADRID</b> Drive north to the impressive Imperial city of <b>Toledo</b> , World Heritage City where the three cultures Christians, Moorish and Jewish, have lived together. Resume of the Spanish art, history and spirituality the whole town is a National Monument. Short guided tour of this historical old town through its narrow streets. Then proceed with a visit to a famous " <b>Damasquinado</b> " (gold and silver inlaying in iron) factory. Continue to <b>Madrid</b> . The rest of the day at leisure. Overnight in Madrid.	<b>(Breakfast)</b>  Toledo (World Heritage City)
<b>08</b> Fri	<b>MADRID - DEPARTURE</b> Depart Madrid, transfer to the airport.	<b>(Breakfast)</b>

## TERMS & CONDITIONS

Passengers are deemed to have read, understood and accepted the following:-

### Package Price

Quoted in Euro Dollar (EUR). Payment in local currency (RM) and subject to exchange rate fluctuations. Validity of prices is seasonal and subject to change without prior notice. Child rates are applicable when child is occupying a room with at least two adults.

### Deposit & Payment

A deposit of 20% of the tour package per person is required when booking is made. Receipt for deposit is valid for three (3) months from the date of issue. The deposit forms part of your final payment. Balance (final payment) must be made 30 days prior to departure. Failure to comply with this may result in an automatic cancellation of your reservations and forfeiture of your deposit.

### Accommodation

Bedding varies from hotel to hotel, but the following usually applies:-

Single Occupancy: comprises 1 Queen/1 Twin Bed

Double Occupancy: comprises 1 Queen/King Bed

Twin Occupancy: comprises 2 Single Beds

Triple Occupancy: comprises 3 Single / 1 Double + Rollaway Bed

If a rollaway bed is required, an extra charge applies. Most hotels will not put more than one rollaway in a room. Baby cots can be requested in advance and if extra charge applies, passenger must pay directly to hotel.

**Hotel Check-In/Out Times :** Standard check-in time is after 1500hrs and check-out is before 1100hrs

### \* Baggage Policy

The warehouse space of the coaches is limited. One suitcase per person of a maximum 25kg and maximum measures of 157cm dimensions (the dimensional measurement in the sum of length, width and height). Only suitcase of higher measure will be accepted if shared between two passengers. Excess baggage penalties: Supplement of €30 per extra standard suitcase; €50 for extra oversize suitcase and €30 for oversize suitcase instead of regular. Only one hand baggage per person is allowed

### Amendment Charges

An administrative fee of RM100 will be charged for each subsequent amendment made after the confirmation. Any other cost arising from the amendment will be borne by the passenger. No amendment can be made within 30 days prior to departure. A change on the entire booking is considered a cancellation and is subject to cancellation charges.

### Cancellation Charges

You may cancel your booking at any time. Cancellation must be made in writing to avoid any misunderstanding. If your cancellation is received by the Company more than 30 days prior to your departure, an administration fee of RM100 per person will be levied. If your notice of cancellation is received fewer than 30 days prior to departure, the following cancellation charges will apply:

### Cancellation Received Cancellation Fee

More than 30 days prior to departure : RM 500 Forfeited

Between 29 to 20 days prior to departure: 20% of tour price

Between 19 to 10 day prior to departure: 50% of tour price

Less than 09days or no-show prior to departure: 100% of tour price

### Refund

No refund will be made for unused tickets or any other unutilized portion of the inclusions. Request for refund as a result of changes to the package must be made in writing and an administrative fee of RM100 per person applies in addition to the supplier's cancellation fee. Refunds are payable only through the original booking agent.
