



1	<b>ISLAMABAD – ARRIVAL</b> Upon arrival at Islamabad International Airport, meet and transfer to hotel for check in. The rest of the day at leisure. Distance: 30km   Driving Hours: 40 mins   Altitude: 220m
2	<b>ISLAMABAD – SWAT VALLEY</b> (Breakfast/ Lunch/ Dinner) Visit <b>Faisal Mosque</b> , followed by the impressive <b>Pakistan Monument</b> and the cultural treasures at Lok Virsa Museum. Continue the tour through the charming lanes of <b>Saidpur Village</b> before departing to Swat Valley. Take in the panoramic views from Daman-e-koh. Arrive Swat, check-in to hotel and enjoy the peaceful alpine surroundings. Distance: 340km   Driving Hours: 5 hours   Altitude: 1000m
3	<b>SWAT VALLEY – GILGIT</b> (Breakfast/ Lunch/ Dinner) After breakfast, begin a stunning drive to Gilgit, with magnificent mountain landscapes unfolding at every turn. Arrive <b>Gilgit</b> , check-in to hotel. Distance: 420km   Driving Hours: 10 hours   Altitude: 1250m
4	<b>GILGIT – HUNZA VALLEY</b> (Breakfast/ Lunch/ Dinner) This morning, we will drive to an enchanting <b>Hunza Valley</b> . En-route stop at the iconic <b>Rakaposhi Viewpoint</b> to view the breathtaking snow-capped peak. Upon arrival, check-in to hotel and relax before heading out for a <b>sunset safari to Eagles Nest</b> where the sky transforms to canvas of golden and crimson hues over the valley. Distance: 150km   Driving Hours: 3 hours   Altitude: 2400m
5	<b>HUNZA VALLEY</b> (Breakfast/ Lunch/ Dinner) Dive into the wonders of Hunza Valley, beginning with a visit to the historic <b>Baltit fort</b> , where centuries old architecture and panoramic views await. Next, explore the local bazaar before moving on to the majestic Altit Fort, which offers a captivating glimpse into the valley's heritage. Distance: 30km   Driving Hours: 2 hours   Altitude: 2400m
6	<b>KARIMABAD – HOPPER VALLEY – GULMIT HUNZA</b> (Breakfast/ Lunch/ Dinner) Embark on a scenic journey to the breathtaking Hopper Valley. Visit to the ancient <b>Ganish Village</b> , a 1000 years old settlement. From there, will hike to the mesmerizing <b>Hopper glacier</b> , surrounded by dramatic landscapes. After lunch, will continue to <b>Attabad Lake</b> , stopping along the way at the sacred Hunza rock carvings. At Attabad lake, will enjoy a <b>boat ride</b> on its crystal clear waters before heading to hotel. Distance: 180km   Driving Hours: 4 hours   Altitude: 2500m
7	<b>GULMIT HUNZA – Khunjerab Pass</b> (Breakfast/ Lunch/ Dinner) Embark to iconic <b>Khunjerab Pass</b> , the highest point on the Karakoram highway, standing at 4,733 meters. This legendary pass, connecting Pakistan and China. Drive through will be view the majestic Karakoram peaks and the distant Pamirs. Upon reaching <b>Khunjerab</b> , spot the Marcopolo sheeps, snow leopards and Himalayan ibexes. Distance: 272km   Driving Hours: 7 hours   Altitude: 4733m
8	<b>GULMIT HUNZA – Passu, Borith Lake – Suspension Bridge</b> (Breakfast/ Lunch/ Dinner) The day begins with a scenic drive to <b>Passu</b> , a guided village walk and visit to a village school. The journey continues toward to the serene <b>Borith Lake</b> , followed by a rewarding hike to a stunning viewpoint overlooking the <b>Passu White Glacier</b> . Continue the route leads back toward Gulmit, with a stop for an exhilarating crossing of the <b>Hussaini Suspension Bridge</b> . Back in Gulmit, enjoy a lunch at local house. Then explorer the village, experience the hospitality of the Upper Hunza Valley. Distance: 85km   Driving Hours: 2 hours   Altitude: 2500m
9	<b>GULMIT – BESHAM</b> (Breakfast/ Lunch/ Dinner) Today journey begins with a scenic drive to Besham. Enroute visit the Junction Point of the world's three great mountain ranges, followed by a stop at the Nanga Parbat Viewpoint. After lunch at Chilas, continue journey to Besham. Distance: 440km   Driving Hours: 10 hours   Altitude: 650m
10	<b>BESHAM – ISLAMABAD – DEPARTURE</b> (Breakfast/ Lunch/ Dinner) Transfer to Islamabad, en-route stop at Taxila, visit the Taxila Museum. After lunch, continue the journey to Islamabad. In the evening, a farewell dinner is arranged. Then transfer to airport. Distance: 270km   Driving Hours: 4-5 hours   Altitude: 540m

## TERMS & CONDITIONS

Passengers are deemed to have read, understood and accepted the following:-

### Package Price

Quoted in Ringgit Malaysia (RM). Validity of prices is seasonal and subject to change without prior notice. Child rates are applicable when child are occupying a room with at least two adult.

### Deposit & Payment

A deposit of RM1000 per person is required when booking is made. Receipt for deposit is valid for three (3) months from the date of issue. The deposit forms part of your final payment. Balance (final payment) must be made 15 days prior to departure. Failure to comply with this may result in an automatic cancellation of your reservations and forfeiture of your deposit.

### Accommodation

Bedding varies from hotel to hotel, but the following usually applies:-

Single Occupancy: comprises 1 Queen/1 Twin Bed

Twin Occupancy: comprises 2 Single Beds

Rollaway Bed

Double Occupancy: comprises 1 Queen/King Bed

Triple Occupancy: comprises 3 Single / 1 Double +

If a rollaway bed is required, an extra charge applies. Most hotels will not put more than one rollaway in a room. Baby cots can be requested in advance and if extra charge applies, passenger must pay directly to hotel.

**Hotel Check-In/Out Times** : Standard check-in time is after 1500hrs and check-out is before 1100hrs

### Amendment Charges

An administrative fee of RM100 will be charged for each subsequent amendment made after the confirmation. Any other cost arising from the amendment will be borne by the passenger. No amendment can be made within 15 days prior to departure. A change on the entire booking is considered a cancellation and is subject to cancellation charges.

### Cancellation Charges

You may cancel your booking at any time. Cancellation must be made in writing to avoid any misunderstanding. If your cancellation is received by the Company more than 30 days prior to your departure, an administration fee of RM100 per person will be levied. ### Cancellation Received Cancellation Fee

Between 30 to 25 days prior to departure: 50% of tour price

Between 25 days to departure day (No-Show): 100% of tour price
