01	<b>CHIANGMAI – ARRIVAL</b> (Lunch / Dinner) Arrive Chiangmai, proceed to <b>Doi Suthep Temple</b> , the famous Wat Prathad Doi Suthep (AD 1384), with over 300 steps and 3,500 feet above sea level. In the evening enjoy Khantoke dinner with Northern Thai Dances.
02	<b>CHIANGMAI - Half day Mae Sa Elephant Camp</b> (Breakfast /Lunch /Dinner) Visit <b>Mae Sa Elephant Camp</b> located north of Chiangmai where you can watch a demonstration of how trained elephants are use in the teak industry. ( <i>Optional 25mins Elephant Ride @ RM55per person –Minimum 2 person required sit on 1 elephant.</i> ) Next stop at <b>Orchid Farm</b> where you can find hundreds of species of rare and colorful blooms. After lunch, continue to visit <b>Home Industries</b> , several villages specializing in different local handicrafts, including silks weaving, woodcarving, silver and lacquer ware and the making of paper umbrellas and a precious stop shop "World largest Gem Gallery".
03	<b>CHIANGMAI – CHIANGRAI</b> (Breakfast /Lunch /Dinner) Depart for <b>Chiangrai</b> overland (183kms) across mountain valley, en-route visit <b>Hot Spring and White Temple (Wat Rong Khun)</b> , a contemporary, privately owned, art exhibit in the style of a Buddhist. Continue visit Eco-Agricultural Hill Tribe Village to see life of the <b>Long Neck Women</b> , also Akha and Yao Hill Tribe. Visit <b>Golden Triangle</b> area where 3 countries borderlines meet Thai-Laos-Burma. Continue to <b>Mae Sai town</b> , the most northern Thai-Burmese border.
04	<b>CHIANGRAI – CHIANGMAI</b> (Breakfast /Lunch /Dinner) After breakfast return to Chiangmai via mountain route. Arrive Chiangmai and transfer to hotel for check in. Rest of the day at leisure.

Passengers are deemed to have read, understood and accepted the following:-

### Package Price

Quoted and payment in Ringgit Malaysia (RM). Validity of prices is seasonal and subject to change without prior notice. Child rates are applicable when child are occupying a room with at least two adult.

### Deposit & Payment

A deposit of RM 200 per person is required when booking is made (subject to change based on travel dates). Receipt for deposit is valid for three (3) months from the date of issued. The deposit forms part of your final payment. Balance (final payment) must be made 30 days prior to departure (subject to confirmation of tour package). Failure to comply with this may result in an automatic cancellation of your reservations and forfeiture of your deposit.

### Accommodation

Bedding various from hotel to hotel, but the following usually apply:-
