




DAY	ITINERARY	
01	ARUSHA - ARRIVAL Arrive Kilimanjaro Airport, meet and greet by our representative and transfer to Arusha town. Check in hotel. The rest of the day at leisure. <i>Arusha, located at the foot of Mount Meru, the sprawling city of Arusha is known as the safari capital of northern Tanzania. It serves as an excellent base from which to explore the remarkably scenic surrounding area which includes majestic Mount Kilimanjaro, as well as the Manyara, Tarangire and Ngorongoro National Parks.</i>	(Dinner) 
02	ARUSHA – TARANGIRE NATIONAL PARK Depart for Tarangire National Park (140kms/approx. 3.5hrs). Arrive at the lodge then check in. Lunch at the lodge. Afternoon game drive begins. Arrive back at the lodge in the evening. At leisure till dinner is served. <i>Tarangire National Park - A popular stop for safaris travelling through the northern circuit on their way to Ngorongoro and the Serengeti. The park extends into two game controlled areas and the wildlife are allowed to move freely throughout. Large herds of elephants and migratory wildebeest, zebra, buffalo, impala, gazelle, hartebeest and eland gather and not surprisingly, the predators follow.</i>	(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner) 
03	TARANGIRE NATIONAL PARK – CENTRAL SERENGETI Depart to crater for morning game drive. Exit the crater and transfer to Serengeti National Park. Stop at Olduvai Gorge Museum for a visit and picnic lunch is served. Continue on to Serengeti National Park and game drive en-route. In the evening arrive at the lodge and check in. <i>Central Serengeti, situated in the heart of Tanzania forms part of the great wildebeest and zebra migration and provides an ideal habitat for a variety of wildlife such as giraffe, impala, waterbuck, hippo, elephant, buffalo, lion, leopard, hyena, jackal, serval and much more. Popular activities include: game viewing, cultural tours, horse riding safaris, and hot air ballooning over the spectacularly scenic terrain.</i>	(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner) 
04	CENTRAL SERENGETI Full day game drive in search of the Big 5 and other wild animals in the park. Enjoy the packed lunch at a convenient picnic site. After lunch, continue game drive. <i>*Should you join the optional Balloon Safari (approximately USD600), this would replace your morning game drive. Pick-up from the lodge will be around 0500hrs and return to the lodge at 1000hrs to continue with the day's safari activities.</i>	(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner) 
05	CENTRAL SERENGETI Continue full day game drive in the park. Enjoy the packed lunch at a convenient picnic site. After lunch, continue game drive.	(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner) 
06	CENTRAL SERENGETI – NGORONGORO CONSERVATION AREA Depart to Ngorongoro Conservation Area (300kms/Approx. 6hrs). Arrive at the lodge and check in. Picnic lunch is served an afternoon game drive begins. <i>Ngorongoro Crater, located in Northern Tanzania, best known for its natural beauty and abundance of diverse wildlife, surrounded by Tanzania's highlands, this UNESCO-listed crater is said to be the world's largest intact volcanic caldera. Visitors can look forward to spotting the world-renowned Big Five and a host of other wildlife species including large herds of zebra and wildebeest.</i>	(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner) 
07	NGORONGORO CONSERVATION AREA – ARUSHA Depart to Arusha (182kms/Approx. 3hrs 30mins). Arrive Arusha, enjoy shopping in the city.	(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)
08	ARUSHA – DEPARTURE Transfer to Kilimanjaro Airport via Arusha Town (120kms/Approx. 1.5hrs) for departure.	(Breakfast)

Package Price

Quoted in US Dollar (USD) and payment in Ringgit Malaysia (RM), subject to currency fluctuation. Validity of prices is seasonal and subject to change without prior notice. Child (3-11yrs) rates are applicable when child are occupying a room with at least two adult.

Deposit & Payment

A deposit of RM2000 per person is required when booking is made. Receipt for deposit is valid for three (3) months from the date of issue. The deposit forms part of your final payment. Balance (final payment) must be made 15 days prior to departure. Failure to comply with this may result in an automatic cancellation of your reservations and forfeiture of your deposit.

Accommodation

Bedding varies from hotel to hotel, but the following usually applies:-

Single Occupancy: comprises 1 Queen/1 Twin Bed

Double Occupancy: comprises 1 Queen/King Bed

Twin Occupancy: comprises 2 Single Beds

Triple Occupancy: comprises 3 Single / 1 Double + Rollaway Bed

If a rollaway bed is required, an extra charge applies. Most hotels will not put more than one rollaway in a room. Baby cots can be requested in advance and if extra charge applies, passenger must pay directly to hotel.

Gratuities: Compulsory US\$20 per day for driver and guide.

Hotel Check-In/Out Times : Standard check-in time is after 1500hrs and check-out is before 1100hrs

Amendment Charges

An administrative fee of RM100 will be charged for each subsequent amendment made after the confirmation. Any other cost arising from the amendment will be borne by the passenger. No amendment can be made within 15 days prior to departure. A change on the entire booking is considered a cancellation and is subject to cancellation charges.

Cancellation Charges
