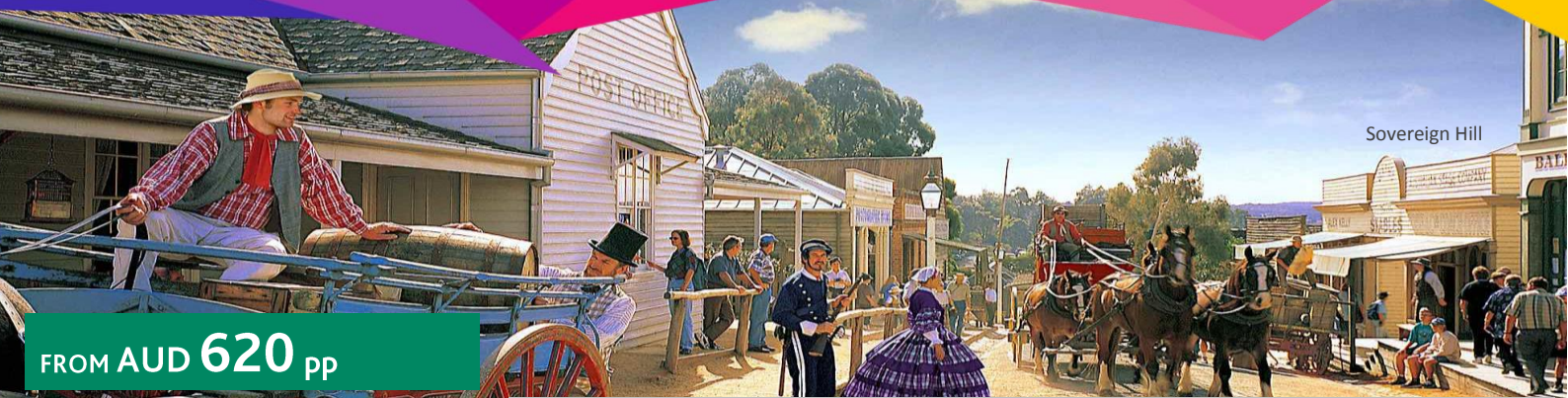

TOUR ITINERARY

**HALF DAY MORNING CITY TOUR (GL/381)**

(Operates Daily; Departs: 8.05am Returns: 12.00pm)

Drive through **Parliament House, Princess Theatre, Royal Exhibition Building**. Take a guided walk through some of Melbourne's best arcades and laneways – **Royal Arcade, Block Place, Block Arcade, Centre Way, Centre Place and Degraves Street**. **Queen Victoria Market** where the largest open air market. Walk through **Flagstaff Gardens**.

** When the Queen Victoria market is closed, will extend laneways & Fitzroy Gardens stop OR visit the Melbourne Cricket Ground (MCG) on Mon and Wed. * Hotel drop-off not available.*

**AFTERNOON HALF DAY MELBOURNE HIGHLIGHTS TOUR (GL/392)**

(Operates daily ; Departs: 1.25pm Returns: 5.30pm)

Visit the **Royal Botanic Gardens, Kings Domain Gardens, Arts and Cultural Centre**. Enjoy spectacular city overview at **Bolte Bridge**. Travel by the beach to trendy **St Kilda**. Photo stop at **Brighton bathing boxes** and tour through the main street of Brighton.

**SOVEREIGN HILL (GL/380)**

(Operates Mon, Tue, Thu, Sat; Departs: 8.15am Returns: 5.30pm)

Visit **Sovereign Hill** an authentic recreation of an 1850's gold mining town. Gold panning in Red gully Creek. Explorer the **Red Hill mine tour** and discover life underground. Witness original working conditions and demonstrations of early mining equipment. Visit the **Gold Museum**, an impressive and valuable collection of gold nuggets, gold coins, alluvial deposits and priceless gold artefacts.

**Sturdy walking shoes are recommended due to uneven and sometimes slippery terrain. Photographs are not permitted in the Underground Mine or at any performances at the Victoria Theatre.*

**PENGUIN PARADE WITH GENERAL VIEWING (GL/384)**

(Operates Daily; Departs: 1:15pm Returns: 9:00pm-11:30pm approx.)

Kuola Conservation Centre – look for koalas in their natural habitat from tree top boardwalks. Witness the **Penguin Parade** on floodlit Summerland Beach from the general viewing area. See penguin rookeries from an elevated boardwalk.

Note: Please bring warm, waterproof clothing as nights can be cold on the island in any season. The Penguin Parade is a natural phenomenon taking place in the open outdoors.

**GREAT OCEAN ROAD ADVENTURE TOUR (GL/396)**

(Operates Daily; Departs: 8:00am Returns: 7:30pm approx...)

Spectacular coastal views along the **Great Ocean Road**. Precipitous coastal cliffs, long sandy beaches and rolling surf. Stop at picturesque **Apollo Bay** for lunch (own expense) - perhaps take a stroll along the picturesque beach front. Huge stone monoliths of the **Twelve Apostles**. Visit the **Loch Ard Gorge** and **Port Campbell**.

Note: Please bring a windbreaker and walking shoes.

**PUFFING BILLY WITH WILDLIFE (GL/399)**

(Operates daily, except Thu & Sat; Departs: 08.15am Returns: 5.45pm)

Visit **Sherbrooke Forest**, the heart of the Dandenongs. Enjoy a ride aboard Puffing Billy steam train from Belgrave to Menzies Creek. Panoramic views from **Grantulla Road**. Enjoy a delicious spit roast lunch with wine as guests of Louise Fergusson. Tour through the Yarra Valley. Visit the **Yarra Valley Chocolaterie & Ice Creamery**. Visit **Healesville Sanctuary**.

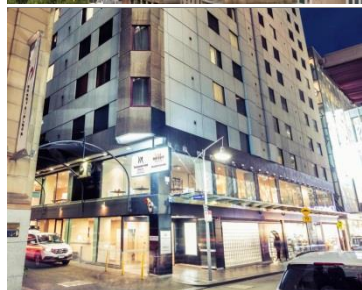

TERMS & CONDITIONS

Passengers are deemed to have read, understood and accepted the following:-

Package Price

Quoted in Australian Dollar (AUD) and payment in Ringgit Malaysia (RM), subject to currency fluctuation. Validity of prices is seasonal and subject to change without prior notice. Child rates are applicable when child are occupying a room with at least two adult.

Deposit & Payment

A deposit of RM500 per person is required when booking is made. Receipt for deposit is valid for three (3) months from the date of issue. The deposit forms part of your final payment. Balance (final payment) must be made 15 days prior to departure. Failure to comply with this may result in an automatic cancellation of your reservations and forfeiture of your deposit.

Accommodation

Bedding varies from hotel to hotel, but the following usually applies:-

Single Occupancy: comprises 1 Queen/1 Twin Bed

Double Occupancy: comprises 1 Queen/King Bed

Twin Occupancy: comprises 2 Single Beds

Triple Occupancy: comprises 3 Single / 1 Double + Rollaway Bed

If a rollaway bed is required, an extra charge applies. Most hotels will not put more than one rollaway in a room. Baby cots can be requested in advance and if extra charge applies, passenger must pay directly to hotel.

Gratuities: AUD5 per person per day

Hotel Check-In/Out Times : Standard check-in time is after 1500hrs and check-out is before 1100hrs

Amendment Charges

An administrative fee of RM100 will be charged for each subsequent amendment made after the confirmation. Any other cost arising from the amendment will be borne by the passenger. No amendment can be made within 15 days prior to departure. A change on the entire booking is considered a cancellation and is subject to cancellation charges.

Cancellation Charges

You may cancel your booking at any time. Cancellation must be made in writing to avoid any misunderstanding. If your cancellation is received by the Company more than 30 days prior to your departure, an administration fee of RM100 per person will be levied. If your notice of cancellation is received fewer than 30 days prior to departure, the following cancellation charges will apply:

Cancellation Received Cancellation Fee

Between 29 to 16 days prior to departure: Forfeiture of the Deposit

Between 15 to 08 days prior to departure: 50% of tour price

Between 7 days to departure day (No-Show): 100% of tour price

Refund

No refund will be made for unused tickets or any other unutilized portion of the inclusions. Request for refund as a result of changes to the package must be made in writing and an administrative fee of RM100 per person applies in addition to the supplier's cancellation fee. Refunds are payable only through the original booking agent.
