#### DAY TOUR ITINERARY (Subject to change) ATHENS - ARRIVAL 1 Upon arrival at Athens airport, meet and transfer to hotel for check in. The rest of the day at leisure. (BREAKFAST) 2 Pick up from hotel and proceed for guided Athens sightseeing tour. Departure to Kalambaka. KALAMBAKA - METEORA - ATHENS (BREAKFAST) Depart for Meteora, The UNESCO World Heritage site is home to more than 20 rock monasteries, either perched precariously on top of Meteora's towering sandstone cliffs or built into the cliffs themselves inside naturally formed caves. Originally lived in by 11th-century hermits, the monasteries later became safe havens for monks fleeing bloodshed when the Roman Empire began to fall. Return to Athens early in the evening. ATHENS - SANTORINI (by Ferry) (BREAKFAST) 7 Transfer to the Piraeus port to embark the ferry to **Santorini** (07:25 – 14:50hrs) Upon arrival, transfer to hotel for check in. Rest of the day at leisure. **SANTORINI** (BREAKFAST) 8 Whole day at leisure.
