DAY 6

THE DALMATIAN COAST TO SPLIT.

Witness a dramatic change in landscape, as you travel through Mediterranean olive groves on your way to Trogir.

☆ Admire the cathedral and Renaissance Čipiko Palace before continuing to the historic port of Split.

☆ The Roman Emperor Diocletian built his palace here and today it forms the nucleus of the Old Town. A Local Expert will lead you through the labyrinthine streets to see St. Dujе's - originally Diocletian's Mausoleum - and the Temple of Jupiter, which today is a baptistery, as well as the Golden Gate. Continue your venture underground, to explore the cellars. (B)

DAY 7 · RELAXED START

ISLAND HOPPING TO HVAR.

☆ Cross the azure waters of the Adriatic to spend two nights on Hvar, famed for being the sunniest island in the country and boasting an interior dotted with lofty mountain peaks and aromatic fields of lavender. (B) (DW)

DAY 11 · RELAXED START

DUBROVNIK, PEARL OF THE ADRIATIC.

Journey to the beautiful southern slopes of the Pelješac Peninsula.

☆ Should weather permit, cruise the tranquil waters of the bay of Mali Ston and admire the surrounding untouched natural beauty, as you enjoy a glass of traditional Croatian brandy.

Stop at a shellfish farm and meet Tomislav, a local oyster farmer, to learn about the cultivation and harvest of oysters. Enjoy a delicious Sea-to-Table tasting of the fresh shellfish, accompanied with a glass of wine.

☆ Continue to the walled town of Dubrovnik, to meet your Local Expert. Explore the Old Town, passing Onofrio's Fountain, the Old Jewish Quarter, the cathedral and the Franciscan and Dominican monasteries. (B) (MT)
