Day 1: MEXICO CITY

Arrive Mexico City, transfer to the hotel.

Day 2: MEXICO CITY (B/L)

Day 3: MEXICO CITY (B/L)

Depart to la Basílica de Guadalupe, the most visited Marian venue in the world. Continue to the Archeological Site of Teotihuacan, city of Gods, where Pirmides del Sol y la Luna located.

Day 4: MEXICO CITY – CUERNAVACA – TAXCO (B/L)

Depart to Cuernavaca, the “city of the eternal spring” thanks to the spring weather during all the year. Visit to the Cathedral and the mains square. Continue to Taxco. Walking city tour around this beautiful town famous for the silver workshops.

Day 5: TAXCO – ACAPULCO (B/L/D)

Transfer to Acapulco – a beach resort town. Check in around midday. Evening at leisure to enjoy the beautiful beaches of Acapulco.

Day 6: ACAPULCO (B/L/D)

Boat ride in the Acapulco Bay (transfer hotel-pier-hotel not included) Suggest to “La Quebrada” for the famous show of the clavadistas (divers).

Day 7: ACAPULCO (B)

Transfer to airport or bus terminal.

ITINERARY

Day 1: MEXICO CITY

Arrive Mexico City, transfer to the hotel.

Day 2: MEXICO CITY (B/L)

The day start in the Historical Centre, UNESCO World Heritage site. Visit el Zocalo, Main Square (Cathedral and National Palace to admire the murals of Diego Rivera). Panoramic tour through historical buildings like Palacio de Bellas Artes, Correos de México (post office). Continue through the Reforma Avenue until the Anthropology Museum*. Visit the most representative rooms of the Aztec and Mayan Culture.

* Stay on your own to visit the rest of the Museum or transfer to your hotel.

Day 3: MEXICO CITY CITY – TUXTLA GUTIERREZ – CANON DEL SUMIDERA – SAN CRISTOBAL de las CASAS (B)

Taking flight to Tuxtla Gutierrez. Tour begin with the fantastic boat ride along the “Cañon del Sumidero”. Later, visit “Chapa de Corzo”, ancient Spanish colony. Continue to the lovely town of “San Cristóbal de las Casas”.

Day 4: SAN CRISTOBAL de las CASAS – NATIVE COMMUNITIES (B)

Walking tour around San Cristobal de las Casas, well known by its coloured embroidered textiles. Later, continue to the native communities of San Juan Chamula with its mystic church and Zinacantan.

Day 5: SAN CRISTOBAL de las CASAS-CASADAS de AGUA AZUL-PALENQUE (B)

Visit to the amazing Agua Azul waterfalls where you'll be delighted with a soothing, refreshing bath in its crystal clear waters. Head on to Palenque.

Day 6: PALENQUE – CAMPECHE (B)

Visit to the archeological site of Palenque, hidden in the Chiapas jungle. Later, continue to Campeche, the only walled city in México.

Day 7: CAMPECHE – UXMAL – MERIDA (B)

Throughout the “Puc Route”, visit the archeological site of Uxmal with its low and horizontal palaces, rich in decoration and sculptures. Continue to Mérida, known as the “White City”.

Day 8: MERIDA – CHICHEN ITZA – CANCUN (B/L/D)

Morning city tour in this colonial city, continuing to the archeological site of Chichen Itza, World Heritage site, representative site of the Mayan culture. Tour end at the paradise beaches of the Mexican Caribbean-Cancun.

Day 9: CANCUN (B/L/D)

Whole day at leisure to enjoy spectacular beaches or do some excursion.

Day 10: CANCUN (B)

Transfer to the airport.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

Passengers are deemed to have read, understood and accepted the following:-

Package Price

Quoted in US Dollar (US\$). Payment in local currency (RM) and subject to exchange rate fluctuations. Validity of prices are seasonal and subject to change without prior notice.

Deposit & Payment

Accommodation

Amendment Charges

Cancellation Charges
